## **MARCH OF REMEMBRANCE ANNOUNCES “SHOAH STORIES” DOCUMENTARY SERIES: “Futuristic technology to preserve the past”**

Seeing the need for remembering the important lessons of the Shoah more than one day per year, March of Remembrance announces sponsorship of a documentary program called “Shoah Stories”, which will utilize a virtual reality platform. Production begins at Baruch HaShem Congregation on April 10 - 12, 2016 in Dallas, TX.

Honored speakers will include Martin Waldman, Rita Slobodkin, Giz Roberson, Dr Jeffrey Seif, Chaim Urbach, Frank Lowinger, Miriam Weygant, Rachel Schiff, Tovah Feldman, and several other invited guests from around the USA.

March of Remembrance will use this occasion for networking regional organizers from around the USA together in preparation for our national prayer walk event on May 1, 2016. We will also hear the vision for Jerusalem 2018 from initiator Pastor Jobst Bittner, Founder of March of Life (Europe) coming with his staff from Tübingen, Germany.

Producer/Director Alex Pearce will be coming from San Francisco with a team of VR Professionals to capture this first event (an example of VR is available on our website at [www.culturalxchange.org](http://www.culturalxchange.org)). The format will be a conversation between four to six people at a round table sharing their testimonies of the war, and then talking together about how their families overcame in the years since. We plan to show the indomitable Jewish spirit of perseverance in the face of overwhelming odds, a program of inspiring hope to all who have suffered tragedy.

Founder and Executive Producer Ted Pearce says, *“VR presents a powerful and exciting platform for story-telling. This amazing new technology will be adopted by millions of people over the next few years, and March of Remembrance believes there are no more compelling stories than those of Shoah survivors. Through this advanced technology we will be able to place the viewer intimately in the midst of these historic figures as they tell their stories of redeeming their lives after experiencing the most unimaginable evil.”*

Exact times on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday are still TBA (to be determined) according to the availability of our honored guest speakers, and further information will be on our website. Another press release will be sent as the date grows closer.
